## SO YOU DON'T BELIEVE THERE IS A NEW WORLD ORDER COMING?

Introduction:

In my last article, "Follow the Money....", I asked the question: "Have a group of evil, greed-driven international financiers really banded together for centuries, behind the world scene, to hoard the wealth of the world; and then use that power of wealth to establish a world economy and then a world government (which they control) to administer that economy?"

Many in the know today say that the international banking elite have already gained financial control of the world, and are only a year or two away from finalizing their one-world economy. A world economy where national borders are erased and regional trade zones (already in effect today (like NAFTA), and soon to be in effect super-regional trade zones (like FTAA) will give way to a global trade agreement that will initiate a one-world economy.

These same people in the know also say that the second phase of the international bankers' global conspiracy was conceived about a hundred years ago—the establishment of a New World Order. (But they said for it to become a reality the wealth of America, and the American taxpayer had to be brought under their control). N.W.O. watchdogs say that the global bankers gained control of the U. S. Taxpayers and financial America in 1913, with the establishing of a Federal Income Tax (collected by the I.R.S.) and the Federal Reserve Bank Act; now they say all that remains for the global elite's New World Order to succeed is for a one-world government to be set up, with their own subservient, bought-and-paid-for politicians in charge. And with their politicians in charge of the world's government, anti-Globalists claim, the international bankers will have the power to forever control the world's economy and maneuver world events to perpetually increase their riches to wealth untold.

Is this true? Have the world's financial elite been plotting behind the scenes for the past hundred years or so to establish a New World Order for economic and political control of the earth; or is the New World Order just a harmless modern phrase George Bush Sr. first used in 1990 to describe a new era of international cooperation that was to come upon the world after the fall of Russian Communism. American anti-Globalists say that up until 1990, and the Gulf War, the United States was living in the "old world order;" a world based on independent nation-states. Now they warn us that this "New World Order," that President Bush Sr. wanted America to embrace with open arms will involve the elimination of the sovereignty and independence of nation-states (especially the U.S.). They strongly caution us that this New World order will eventually mean the end of the United States of America, the U.S. Constitution, and the Bill of Rights as we now know them.

Americans against Globalism also inform us that most of the New World Order's proposals involve the conversion of the United Nations and its agencies (or some organization like the UN) into a more substantial global power with the authority and ability to enforce the directives of their chosen leader. They contend that this super-UN Chief Executive Officer (or CEO) shall be given the power to establish a world government, complete with a world army, a world parliament, a world court, global taxation, and numerous other agencies to control every aspect of human life, including education, nutrition, health care, population, immigration, communications, transportation, commerce, agriculture, finance, and the environment.

Are they right? Again, I want to let you, the reader, be the judge. Is there a New World Order coming, or not? And if there is World Order coming, is that New Order, with its prophesied One-World Government good or bad for the United States of America and her people?

I offer this as just an aside piece of information: Emory University (in Atlanta) is a big supporter of the United Nations, and has long been recognized by the anti-Globalists as a haven for Globalists and supporters of World Government. And, they say, that the University adamantly believes and teaches that Globalism and a New International World Order is the future of the world. Something I found interesting: the Woodruff General Library at Emory has, just in its stacks alone, 187 books with the words "New World Order" in their titles; and another 827 books with the words "Globalism" or "Globalization" on their covers.

The following quotations, by opponents and proponents of the New World Order, demonstrate one thing for sure—the words, "New World Order," have been in use for decades. They did not recently originate with President George Bush in 1990. (The quotes are in no particular order.)

Proponents of the New World Order:

"Today, I say that no nation in the world need be left out of the global system we are constructing," (Madeline Albright, 1997 Harvard University commencement.)

"We are not going to achieve a new world order without paying for it in blood as well as in words and money." (Arthur Schlesinger, Jr., in "Foreign Affairs," July/August 1995.)

"Today, America would be outraged if U.N. troops entered Los Angeles to restore order. Tomorrow they will be grateful! This is especially true if they were told that there were an outside threat from beyond [i.e., an "extraterrestrial" invasion], whether real or promulgated, that threatened our very existence. It is then that all peoples of the world will plead for us to deliver them from this evil. The one thing every man fears is the unknown. When presented with this scenario, individual rights will be willingly relinquished for the guarantee of their well-being granted to them by the World

Government." [referring to the 1991 LA Riot]. (Dr. Henry Kissinger, Bilderberger Conference, Evians, France, 1991.)

"We are grateful to The Washington Post, The New York Times, Time Magazine and other great publications whose directors have attended our meetings and respected their promises of discretion for almost forty years. It would have been impossible for us to develop our plan for the world if we had been subject to the bright lights of publicity during those years. But, the work is now much more sophisticated and prepared to march towards a world government. The supranational sovereignty of an intellectual elite and world bankers is surely preferable to the national auto-determination practiced in past centuries." (David Rockefeller, founder of the Trilateral Commission, in an address to a meeting of The Trilateral Commission, in June, 1991.)

"In the next century, nations as we know it will be obsolete; all states will recognize a single, global authority. National sovereignty wasn't such a great idea after all." (Strobe Talbot, President Clinton's Deputy Secretary of State, as quoted in Time, July 20th, 1992.)

"We shall have world government whether or not you like it, by conquest or consent." (Statement by Council on Foreign Relations (CFR) member James Warburg to The Senate Foreign Relations Committee on February 17th, 1950.)

"...In short, the 'house of world order' will have to be built from the bottom up rather than from the top down. It will look like a great 'booming, buzzing confusion,' to use William James' famous description of reality, but an end run around national sovereignty, eroding it piece by piece, will accomplish much more than the old-fashioned frontal assault." (Richard N. Gardner, in "Foreign Affairs," April 1974.)

"The existing order is breaking down at a very rapid rate, and the main uncertainty is whether mankind can exert a positive role in shaping a new world order or is doomed to await collapse in a passive posture. We believe a new order will be born no later than early in the next century and that the death throes of the old and the birth pangs of the new will be a testing time for the human species." (Global visionary Richard A. Falk, in a chapter entitled "Toward a New World Order: Modest Methods and Drastic Visions," of the book "On the Creation of a Just World Order" - 1975)

"My country's history, Mr. President, tells us that it is possible to fashion unity while cherishing diversity, that common action is possible despite the variety of races, interests, and beliefs we see here in this chamber. Progress and peace and justice are attainable. So we say to all peoples and governments: Let us fashion together a new world order." (Henry Kissinger, in address before the General Assembly of the United Nations, October 1975)

"A New World Order" (Title of article on commencement address at the University of Pennsylvania by Hubert H. Humphrey, printed in the Pennsylvania Gazette - June 1977)

"Further global progress is now possible only through a quest for universal consensus in the movement towards a new world order." (Mikhail Gorbachev, in an address at the United Nations - December 1988)

"...This regionalization is in keeping with the Tri-Lateral Plan which calls for a gradual convergence of East and West, ultimately leading toward the goal of 'one world government'...National sovereignty is no longer a viable concept..." (Zbigniew Brzezinski, National Security Advisor to President Jimmy Carter.)

"By the end of this decade (2000 AD) we will live under the first One World Government that has ever existed in the society of nations ... a government with absolute authority to decide the basic issues of human survival. One world government is inevitable." (Pope John Paul II quoted by Malachi Martin in the book "The Keys of This Blood")

"The New World Order is a world that has a supranational authority to regulate world commerce and industry; an international organization that would control the production and consumption of oil; an international currency that would replace the dollar; a World Development Fund that would make funds available to free and Communist nations alike; and an international police force to enforce the edicts of the New World Order." (Former West German Chancellor Willy Brandt.)

"We are on the verge of a global transformation. All we need is the right major crisis and the nations will accept the New World Order." (David Rockefeller)

"But this present window of opportunity, during which a truly peaceful and interdependent world order might be built, will not be open for long. Already there are powerful forces at work that threaten to destroy all of our hopes and efforts to erect an enduring structure of global interdependence." (David Rockefeller, speaking at the Business Council for the United Nations, September 14, 1994.)

"A colossal event is upon us, the birth of a New World Order." (Brent Scowcroft, George Bush's National Security Advisor, said on the eve of the Gulf War.)

"The world can therefore seize the opportunity (the Persian Gulf crisis) to fulfill the long held promise of a New World Order where diverse nations are drawn together in common cause to achieve the universal aspirations of mankind." (President George Bush in his State of the Union Address, January 29, 1991.)

"NAFTA is a major stepping stone to the New World Order." (Henry Kissinger while campaigning for the passage of NAFTA.)

"Further global progress is now possible only through a quest for universal consensus in the movement towards a new world order." (Mikhail Gorbachev, in an address at the United Nations, December 1988.)

"To achieve world government, it is necessary to remove from the minds of men their individualism, loyalty to family traditions, national patriotism, and religious dogmas." (Brock Adams, Director UN Health Organization)

"A world government can intervene militarily in the internal affairs of any nation when it disapproves of their activities." (Kofi Annan, U.N. Secretary General)

"We are at present working discreetly with all our might to wrest this mysterious force called sovereignty out of the clutches of the local nation states of the world. All the time we are denying with our lips what we are doing with our hands....." (Professor Arnold Toynbee, in a June 1931 speech before the Institute for the Study of International Affairs in Copenhagen.)

"The case for government by elites is irrefutable." (Senator William Fulbright, Former chairman of the US Senate Foreign Relations Committee, stated at a 1963 symposium entitled: The Elite and the Electorate - Is Government by the People Possible?)

"The powers of financial capitalism had another far reaching aim, nothing less than to create a world system of financial control in private hands able to dominate the political system of each country and the economy of the world as a whole. ("Tragedy and Hope: A History of The World in Our Time" Professor Carroll Quigley of Georgetown University, highly esteemed by his former student, Bill Clinton.)

"Undersecretary of State Sumner Welles tonight called for the early creation of an international organization of anti-Axis nations to control the world during the period between the armistice at the end of the present war and the setting up of a new world order on a permanent basis." (Text of article in "The Philadelphia Inquirer" - June 1942)

"The developing coherence of Asian regional thinking is reflected in a disposition to consider problems and loyalties in regional terms, and to evolve regional approaches to development needs and to the evolution of a new world order." (Richard Nixon, in "Foreign Affairs" - October 1967)

"We can see beyond the present shadows of war in the Middle East to a new world order where the strong work together to deter and stop aggression. This was precisely Franklin Roosevelt's and Winston Churchill's vision for peace for the post-war period." (Richard Gephardt, in "The Wall Street Journal" - September 1990)

"The new world order that is in the making must focus on the creation of a world of democracy, peace and prosperity for all." (Nelson Mandela, in "The Philadelphia Inquirer" - October 1994)

The renewal of the nonproliferation treaty was described as important "for the welfare of the whole world and the new world order." (President Hosni Mubarak of Egypt, in "The New York Times" - April 1995)

"The old world order changed when this war storm broke [WWI]--the old world order died with the setting of the day's sun and a new world order is being born while I speak."

(Nicholas Murray Butler, Columbia Univ. president, in his November 27, 1915 speech "New World Order is Being Born," given to the Union League of Philadelphia.)

"It is the system of nationalist individualism that has to go... We are living in the end of the sovereign states.... In the great struggle to evoke a Westernized World Socialism, contemporary governments may vanish.... Countless people... will hate the new world order.... and will die protesting against it." (Written by H. G. Wells in his 1940 book, "The New World Order.")

"... World government could not be accepted without radical change of national outlook.... It will take a long time to prepare peoples and governments of most nations for acceptance of and participation in a world government.... If we expect this future world government to be created by agreement and not by force or conquest, we will have to be willing to work patiently until peoples or governments are ready for it...." Written in an article, which appeared in "United Nations World" in 1949, by Ambassador Warren Austin, chief of the U.S. Mission to the UN.)

"As long as the child breathes the poisoned air of nationalism, education in world-mindedness can produce only rather precarious results.... For the moment, it is sufficient to note that it is most frequently in the family that the children are infected with nationalism by hearing what is national extolled and what is foreign disparaged.... The activity of the school cannot bring about the desired result unless, repudiating every form of nationalism..." (Written in a 1949 publication of The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization [UNESCO] entitled, "Towards World Understanding.") Could this be why the American family is constantly under attack by UN affiliated organizations?

"I think the subject which will be of most importance politically is mass psychology.... The populace will not be allowed to know how its convictions were generated. When the technique has been perfected, every government that has been in charge of education for a generation will be able to control its subjects securely without the need of armies or policemen.... Educational propaganda, with government help, could achieve this result in a generation. There are, however, two powerful forces opposed to such a policy: one is religion; the other is nationalism.... A scientific world society cannot be stable unless there is a world government." (Written by Fabian Socialist Bertrand Russell in his 1953 publication, "The Impact of Science on Society.") Could this be why the world's academic and scientific communities are so pro-Evolution and anti-God today?

"The most effective transmitting instrument possible for the coming of the new world order.... He is continuously revolutionary in the new way without ever provoking a stark revolutionary crisis." (In his 1958 book, "The Coming of the New Deal," Arthur Schlesinger, Jr. quotes Fabian Socialist H. G. Well describing FDR.)

"We are living in a perilous period of transition from the era of the fully sovereign nation-state to the era of world government." (Written by James Warburg in his 1959

book, "The West in Crisis." James Warburg is the founder of the United World Federalists, and is also the son of Paul Warburg, an architect of the Federal Reserve.)

"A world effectively controlled by the United Nations is one in which "world government" would come about through the establishment of supranational institutions, characterized by mandatory universal membership and some ability to employ physical force....(But) if the communist dynamic was greatly abated, the West might lose whatever incentive it has for world government." (Written in March 10, 1962 State Dept. Study Memorandum No. 7, "A World Effectively Controlled by the United Nations.") Anti-Globalists say that today: "It looks as if now the 'communists menace' has been replaced by the 'terrorist menace.' And of course they [the Globalists] can switch back to the communist menace or any other kind of menace whenever they want to." [They mean here that the Globalists' plan is for Americans must have some kind of manufactured "menace" to fight against, and occupy their time, while the Global elite secretly proceed behind the scene with their plans to establish a new world order.]

"Who can fail to see the need and importance of thus gradually coming to the establishment of a world authority capable of taking effective action on the juridical and political planes? Delegates to international organizations, public officials, gentlemen of the press, teachers and educators--all of you must realize that you have your part to play in the construction of a new world order." (Written on March 26, 1967, by Pope Paul VI in his publication "Populorum Progressio.")

"Marxism represents a further vital and creative stage in the maturing of man's universal vision. Marxism is simultaneously a victory of the external, active man over the inner, passive man and a victory of reason over belief....Human beings become increasingly manipulable and malleable...Today we are again witnessing the emergence of transnational elites....whose ties cut across national boundaries....The nation-state is gradually yielding its sovereignty....Further progress will require greater American sacrifices. More intensive efforts to shape a new world monetary structure will have to be undertaken." (Written by Zbigniew Brzezinski in his 1970 book, "Between Two Ages: America's Role in the Technetronic Era." He was the first director of the Trilateral Commission and President Carter's national security advisor.)

"...A new world order is taking shape so fast that governments are well as private citizens find it difficult just to absorb the gallop of events...." (Comment by Mikhail Gorbachev quoted in Washington Post February 25, 1990.)

"Tolerance is the alpha and omega of a new world order...." (Comments of Mikhail Gorbachev speaking at Stanford University, quoted by Sentinel wire services June 5, 1990.)

"Now, our President faces greater tasks. And he must have help from like-minded men and women in the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate who can help him establish the "new world order" he seeks." (A quote from an invitation sent to Republican contributors throughout the United States in May 1991.)

“All countries are basically social arrangements....No matter how permanent or even sacred they may seem at any one time, in fact they are all artificial and temporary....Perhaps national sovereignty wasn't such a great idea after all....But it has taken the events in our own wondrous and terrible century to clinch the case for world government.” (Written in the July 20, 1992 issue of “Time” magazine in an article entitled, "The Birth of the Global Nation" by Strobe Talbott - Rhodes scholar roommate of Bill Clinton at Oxford University.)

"...you had me on (before) to talk about the new world order....I talk about it all the time....It's one world now....Willing or not, ready or not, we are all involved." (Spoken to Charlie Rose on his May 4, 1993 TV show by Leslie Gelb, President Emeritus of the Council on Foreign Relations [CFR], and former editor of “The New York Times.”)

"What Congress will have before it is not a conventional trade agreement but the architecture of a new international system....a first step toward a new world order.” (Written by Henry Kissinger in the July 18, 1993 issue of “The Los Angeles Times” concerning NAFTA.)

“If we are to avoid catastrophe, a system of world order—preferably a system of world government—is mandatory. The proud nations someday will ....yield up their precious sovereignty.” (Written by Walter Cronkite in his 1996 book, “A Reporter's Life.”)

"How I Learned to Love the New World Order" (Article by Sen. Joseph R. Biden, Jr. in The Wall Street Journal - April 1992)

"How to Achieve The New World Order" (Title of book excerpt by Henry Kissinger, in Time magazine - March 1994.)

"New World Order: The Rise of the Region-State" (Title of article by Kenichi Ohmae, political reform leader in Japan, in The Wall Street Journal - August 1994.)

"Our task of creating a socialist America can only succeed when those who would resist us have been totally disarmed." (Sara Brady, Chairman, Handgun Control, to Sen. Howard Metzenbaum, “The National Educator”, January 1994, Page 3.)

### Opponents of the New World Order

Warning his “20 million listeners” to beware of the ever-growing army of “socialist utopians” (globalists and internationalists) in America today, Limbaugh said that they were an army who want to do away with the independent nation-state we live in today in favor of a ‘region’ which they want to set up as part of their “New World Order.” (Rush

Limbaugh on his May 21, 1999 national radio program.) (I'm still not sure if he opposes it.)

"The drive of the Rockefellers and their allies is to create a one-world government combining supercapitalism and Communism under the same tent, all under their control.... Do I mean conspiracy? Yes I do. I am convinced there is such a plot, international in scope, generations old in planning, and incredibly evil in intent." (Spoken by anti-N.W.O. Congressman Larry P. McDonald in 1976, before he was killed in the Korean Airlines 747 that was shot down by the Soviets in 1983.)

"The Council on Foreign Relations is "the establishment." Not only does it have influence and power in key decision-making positions at the highest levels of government to apply pressure from above, but it also announces and uses individuals and groups to bring pressure from below, to justify the high level decisions for converting the U.S. from a sovereign Constitutional Republic into a servile member state of a one-world dictatorship." (Spoken by former Congressman John Rarick in 1971.)

"In March, 1915, the J.P. Morgan interests....got together 12 men high up in the newspaper world and employed them to select the most influential newspapers in the United States....to control generally the policy of the daily press....An agreement was reached; the policy of the papers was bought....an editor was furnished for each paper to properly supervise and edit information regarding the questions of preparedness, militarism, financial policies, and other things of national and international nature considered vital to the interests of the purchasers." (Stated by U.S. Congressman Oscar Callaway in 1917.)

"There is no such thing as an independent press in America at this date of the world's history. You know it and I know it....If I allowed my honest opinions to appear in one issue of my paper, before twenty-four hours my occupation would be gone...The business of the journalist is to destroy the truth, to lie outright, to pervert, to vilify, to fawn at the feet of mammon, and to sell his country...for his daily bread. You know it and I know it....We are the tools and vassals of rich men behind the scenes. We are the jumping jacks; they pull the strings, and we dance....We are intellectual prostitutes." (Spoken in a toast to the New York Press Club in 1953 by John Swinton, editor-in-chief of The New York Times, and a man revered as the dean of his profession.) Those who own and control America's major newspapers today, also conveniently own and control her major radio and television stations too. Could that be why our national news media is so against American sovereignty and biased toward socialism?

"For a long time I felt that FDR had developed many thoughts and ideas that were his own to benefit this country, the United States. But, he didn't. Most of his thoughts, his political ammunition, as it were, were carefully manufactured for him in advanced by the Council on Foreign Relations-One World Money group. Brilliantly, with great gusto, like a fine piece of artillery, he exploded that prepared "ammunition" in the middle of an unsuspecting target, the American people...." (Curtis Dall, FDR's son-in-law as quoted in his book, "My Exploited Father-in-Law".)

"The Trilateral Commission is intended to be the vehicle for multinational consolidation of the commercial and banking interests by seizing control of the political government of the United States. The Trilateral Commission represents a skillful, coordinated effort to seize control and consolidate the four centers of power: political, monetary, intellectual and ecclesiastical. What the Trilateral Commission intends is to create a worldwide economic power superior to the political governments of the nation states involved. As managers and creators of the system, they will rule the future." (U.S. Senator Barry Goldwater in his 1964 book: "With No Apologies.")

"The term Internationalism has been popularized in recent years to cover an interlocking financial, political, and economic world force for the purpose of establishing a World Government. Today Internationalism is heralded from pulpit and platform as a 'League of Nations' or a 'Federated Union' to which the United States must surrender a definite part of its National Sovereignty. The World Government plan is being advocated under such alluring names as the 'New International Order,' 'The New World Order,' 'World Union Now,' 'World Commonwealth of Nations,' 'World Community,' etc. All the terms have the same objective; however, the line of approach may be religious or political according to the taste or training of the individual." (Excerpt from a memorial address given to the leaders of the Protestant Episcopal Church at their General Convention in 1940).

"the World Trade Organization is creating a world government in which one organization which is totally unelected, wholly secretive....with the power to virtually override any local or national laws if those in any way inconvenience global corporations....It was a terrible shock (to those of us who supported Bill Clinton) when Clinton came in and GATT and NAFTA became the centerpieces of his policy....And in a sense, there was almost a seamless transition from President Bush to President Clinton in that regard....Our democracy has been rendered meaningless by big money. The truth is there are politicians (who) are owned lock, stock and barrel by the big money interests....Our elections create, to some extent, a facade of choice." (Stated by David C. Korten, author of "When Corporations Rule the World" (1995), in a May 11, 1996 interview with journalist Joan Veon.)

"The most powerful clique in these (CFR) groups have one objective in common: they want to bring about the surrender of the sovereignty and the national independence of the U.S. They want to end national boundaries and racial and ethnic loyalties supposedly to increase business and ensure world peace. What they strive for would inevitably lead to dictatorship and loss of freedoms by the people. The CFR was founded for "the purpose of promoting disarmament and submergence of U.S. sovereignty and national independence into an all-powerful one-world government." (Harpers Magazine, July 1958.)

Conclusion:

We have just read the comments and warnings of prominent Americans and world citizens, who specialize in academics, business, politics, military, and even religion. We are now aware of their thoughts on both sides of the issue: many of them warned us how bad the N.W.O. is going to be for American sovereignty, but the rest told us how good the N.W.O. is going to be for world unity. But one thing they all seemed to agree on: there is definitely a New World Order coming to this Earth.

In thinking about the New World Order, I have a few questions that need answering. If there is a New World Order coming; and if it is supposed to usher in a world government that will improve the quality of life for the average American, and benefit all peoples of the world, then why is the future government of the New World Order not patterned after America's original government.

After all, the American way of life, which our Founding Fathers established with God's help, has made our country the envy of the entire world today. For the past 200 years, millions of people from all around the world have abandoned their homeland and their families to come to America. Many of them risked their lives just for the chance to become U.S. citizens, and live in the United States of America, the greatest nation on Earth; once affectionately referred to throughout the world as "the promise land."

So, if our national leaders, as well as international leaders, are so anxious to create the perfect utopian government, where all nations can live in peace and harmony without interference from dictators and tyrants, then why not pattern their one-world government after our original government? The whole world envies the United States, and always has, because it is the greatest nation on earth. Why aren't the globalists trying to make the rest of the world more like America, than America like the rest of the world? Could it be that the U.S. Constitution, designed by Almighty God and our Founding Fathers, is written in a way to prevent global tyrants from usurping the sovereignty of the United States? Does it temporarily stand in the way of the New World Order? Must the U.S. Constitution be compromised before World Government can succeed?

Did you notice, in reading the above quotes, that both of America's political parties, the Democrats and Republicans, seem just as eager to see the New World Order emerge? It seems that most all of America's prominent "Liberal" and "Conservative" politicians are in favor of the same thing as the socialist dictators and political tyrants from around the world are—the establishment of a New World Order. It is as though the vast majority of politicians in America and the world today are marching to the same beat of a higher power—and I don't mean Jesus Christ of Nazareth. It makes you wonder, are the wealthy international bankers and global elite really interested in setting up a utopian world order, where peace and brotherhood rule; or could it be they want to create a world where they rule with absolute power?

I mentioned Jesus Christ. Is there any room for Him in the plans of the New World Order? Apparently not, but there are plans for religion within the New Order, just not Christ. In fact, the financial and political "powers that be," recognizing that the common people need religion in their lives to be content, established the New World Order on four pillars—politics, military, economy, and religion. Those who have studied the N.W.O.

say that the Globalists would have preferred to leave religion out of the equation, but since they perceive religious differences as the final barrier to the New World Order, they manufactured plans for a global religion. In fact, plans for religious fusion have been under way for quite some time, with the creation of a United Religions (UR), a religious organization that mirrors the United Nations.

In his 2000 book, “One World,” Tal Brooke describes what the globalists plans are for a their Global Religion; he reported that: “An international Who's Who of statesmen, intellectuals and financial leaders met on June 25, 1995 at the U.N.'s 50th anniversary in San Francisco at Grace Cathedral. At the key ceremony, it was revealed that Mikhail Gorbachev, the former head of the Soviet Union, had the backing of world leaders to set up a United Nations sister organization in San Francisco called the United Religions. Modeled on the U.N., it would have a 500-member assembly, a 36-member executive council, and a general secretary. Multi-faith peacemaker teams would be dispatched around the world by the "U.R." to trouble spots, just like the U.N. In the summer of 2000, in Pittsburgh, the charter for the United Religions was signed right on schedule.”

The socialist-minded world political and financial elite believe that if the nations of the world would just join their UR, they would all stop fighting each other, and world or cooperation and prosperity would be the results. Using the same format of thought—that men can manufacture world peace—the religious leaders in America and the English-speaking world today believe if everyone simply kept Christmas every day, world peace would automatically emerge.

The Apostle Paul was much more than just a great Christian preacher of right and wrong, he was also a mighty defender of the Faith, who warned the fledgling Christian world back then of what would happen to them if they abandoned the Gospel of Christ that he preached and followed after another gospel. Well, early Christianity did abandon their love of the Truth, and consequently Satan lured the vast majority of professing Christians away from Christ to follow his gospel—a strong Christian delusion (Satan’s Roman Catholic conspiracy against the Truth of God).

"The powers of financial capitalism had another far reaching aim, nothing less than to create a world system of financial control in private hands able to dominate the political system of each country and the economy of the world as a whole. This system was to be controlled in a feudalist fashion by the central banks of the world acting in concert, by secret agreements, arrived at in frequent private meetings and conferences. The apex of the system was the Bank for International Settlements in Basel, Switzerland, a private bank owned and controlled by the world's central banks which were themselves private corporations. The growth of financial capitalism made possible a centralization of world economic control and use of this power for the direct benefit of financiers and the indirect injury of all other economic groups."

"It is well enough that the people of the nation do not understand our banking and monetary system, for if they did, I believe there would be a revolution before tomorrow morning." – Henry Ford, founder of the Ford Motor Company.

"Most Americans have no real understanding of the operation of the international moneylenders. The bankers want it that way. We recognize in a hazy sort of way that the Rothschilds, and the Warburgs of Europe and the houses of J. P. Morgan, Kuhn, Loeb and Company, Schiff, Lehman and Rockefeller possess and control vast wealth. How they acquire this vast financial power and employ it is a mystery to most of us.

#### A Brief History of our Early Banking System:

"In the colonies we issue our own money. It is called Colonial Script. We issue it in proper proportion to the demands of trade and industry to make the products pass easily from the producers to the consumers...In this manner, creating for ourselves our own paper money, we control its purchasing power, and we have no interest to pay to no one." (Benjamin Franklin)

"Hamilton believed in strong central government and a central bank overseen by a wealthy elite. 'No society could succeed which did not unite the interest and credit of rich individuals with those of the state,' he wrote. Supporters of Hamilton's elitist ideals formed America's first political party, the Federalists. Hamilton, once described as a 'tool of the international bankers,' argued that 'a national debt, if it is not excessive, will be to us a national blessing.'

The Bank of North America was created in 1781, even before the drafting of the Constitution, by Continental Congressman Robert Morris, who tried to craft it into a central bank copying the Bank of England. It lasted just three years before being discontinued due to rampant fraud and the inflation caused by the creation of baseless 'fiat' currency.

Hamilton, a former aid to Morris, became secretary of the Treasury and in 1791 headed the next attempt at a central bank by establishing the First Bank of the United States, a move strongly opposed by Jefferson and his followers.

Jefferson knew from European history that a central bank could quickly become the master of a nation.” (“Rule By Secrecy,” Jim Marrs)

“Jefferson was not alone among the Founding Fathers to express distaste over the profit of banking. ‘Our whole banking system I ever abhorred, I continue to Abhor, and I shall die abhorring...’ wrote John Adams in 1811.”

“The First Bank of the United States also was closely modeled after the Bank of England and created a partnership between the government and banking interests. Twenty percent of the bank’s capital was obtained through the federal government with the remaining 80 percent pledged by private investors, including foreigners such as the Rothschilds. ‘The law records show that they [the Rothschilds] were the power in the old Bank of the United States,’ wrote author Gustavus Myers. It is clear that conspiring European bankers and their New World associates were trying to gain control over America’s money supply.”

“This bank also caused inflation by the creation of fractional-reserve notes. Money merchants prospered but the average citizen suffered. In 1811, when the bank’s twenty-year charter came up for renewal, it was defeated by one vote in both the Senate and the House. But the costs of the War of 1812, along with chaotic financial conditions, prompted Congress to issue a twenty-year charter to the Second Bank of the United States in 1816. This central bank ended in 1836, after President Andrew Jackson in 1832 vetoed a congressional bill to extend its charter, precipitating what became known as the Bank War. Jackson...denounced the central bank as unconstitutional as well as ‘a curse to a republic; inasmuch as it is calculated to raise around the administration a moneyed aristocracy dangerous to the liberties of the country.’

“It was probably no coincidence that America’s first assassination attempt was made on Jackson in 1835 by a man named Richard Lawrence, who claimed to be ‘in touch with the powers in Europe.’ Lawrence’s pistols misfired, and the unharmed by infuriated Jackson withdrew government funds from the ‘den of vipers’ and Second Bank president Nicholas Biddle retaliated by curtailing credit nationally, accusing widespread economic panic. According to author Eustace Mullins, Biddle was an agent of Jacob Rothschild in Paris.

“Next, Jackson was censured by Biddle’s friends in the Senate by a vote of 26-20 for failure to obtain Congressional authorization to withdraw the funds. The political motivation behind this action was confirmed in 1837, when the Senate annulled Jackson’s censure by a 24-19 vote. Biddle disappeared from the scene, and by the end of his two terms ‘Old Hickory’ had managed to totally eliminate the national debt.

Jackson saw Biddle's maneuverings as a bald-faced attempt to blackmail the government into renewing the bank's charter. He warned, "The bold effort the present bank had made to control the Government, the distress it had wantonly produced....are but premonitions of the fate that awaits the American people should they be deluded into a perpetuation of this institution, or the establishment of another like it."

Other attempts were made to resurrect a central bank, but none succeeded until the creation of the Federal Reserve System in 1913.

Plans For a Global Bank and a Global Currency:

"If the key to controlling a nation is to run its central bank, one can imagine the potential of a 'global' central bank, able to dictate the world's credit and money supply. The roots of such a system were planted when the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank were formed at the Bretton Woods (Vermont) Conference of 1944."

"A. K. Chesterton, the distinguished British author, declared: 'The final act of Bretton Woods, which gave birth to the World Bank and International Monetary Fund....and many similar assemblies of hand-picked functionaries were not incubated by hard-pressed Governments engaged in waging war, but a Supra-national Money Power which could afford to look ahead to the shaping of a post-war world that would serve its interest.'"

"The IMF was ostensibly set up to control international exchange rates and 'stabilize currencies,' but is the framework for a central (global) bank of issue. It is noteworthy that at Bretton Woods, Federal Reserve Board governor Mariner Eccles observed: 'An international currency is synonymous with international government.'" John Maynard Keynes, the leading British figure at the (1944) Conference, proposed a world currency which he called 'bancor,' but this plan was rejected as too radical to gain international acceptance (back then). However this goal has not been abandoned. Dr. Johannes Witteveen, former head of the IMF, said in 1975 that the agency should become 'the exclusive issuer of official international reserve assets.' In the fall 1984 'Foreign Affairs', Richard N. Cooper laid out a modern plan for international currency. He wrote: 'A new Bretton Woods conference is wholly premature. But it is not premature to begin thinking about how we would like international monetary arrangements to evolve in the remainder of this century. With this in mind, I suggest a radical alternative scheme for the next century: the creation of a common currency for all the industrial democracies, with a common monetary policy and a joint Bank of Issue to determine that monetary policy.'"

"The IMF's sister, the World Bank, was supposedly established to help postwar reconstruction and development. It is an international lending agency, but what it lends more than anything else is dollars from the U.S. taxpayer."
